1. Each Member in good standing may display up to two pieces of 2D or 3D work ***no larger than 36”x 36” x 36”*** including **FRAMEWORK AT NO COST**. Each member may add up to three additional pieces at a cost of \$5 each, all check payments are to be sent with your registration form, and a notation designated on the check for VAA Fall Member Exhibit.
 2. Each member is responsible for delivery and pick up of their artwork within the dates and times set by the coordinator and the venue.
 3. All work MUST be original member’s work, been completed in the past two years, and NEVER displayed previously at the Heyde Center. Prints and embellished prints of work are allowed but must be identified/labeled as such.
 4. All work will be screened by VAA/Heyde coordinator, who reserve right to deny an artwork, with reasonable explanation, with the artist allowed a suitable replacement in a timely manner. (If there is a question, please contact the coordinator in ADVANCE of application.)
 5. Proper display criteria and hardware are required for all pieces, which are as follows: D-rings and eyehook hangers with suitable wire, NO sawtooth hangers. If 3D work requires stands or museum tack please include it with your entry along with display instructions. Coordinator and team will hang and display artwork.
 6. Each artwork MUST have name, title, original/print, media, size, price or NFS indicated somewhere on the piece. The attached inventory form must accompany the artwork when delivered to venue. Heyde/VAA will provide display labels for this show.
 7. *Heyde Center and VAA coordinator will do everything possible to safeguard and protect all artwork from loss or damage.* Thus, artist permits the Heyde Center to house and display artwork (maintaining personal insurance coverage, if desired) and will not hold the Heyde Center or VAA responsible for any damages or theft of their work. Heyde Center carries limited liability for property in the case of catastrophic events such as fire, storm, etc.
 8. VAA/Heyde Center will provide marketing, promotional materials, and web presence. Heyde Center will take a 30% Commission on all artwork that is for sale while on display and is responsible for collecting, filing all sales tax, and push out of work.
