

#### Pop UP WRAP 2024

The first VAA Pop Up WRAP is done. It was full of energy and enthusiasm as 22 VAA and non-VAA members gathered to talk art. Nearly 40 pieces were brought for judging by our judge Kay Brathol-Hostvet. Most of us gathered during the judging process for a workshop to hear about Color, Value, Composition, Line, Texture, Shapes, and Form. Our in-house experts, Mary Hermanson, Karen Scarceth, and Jeff Nelson shared their art expertise as artists and educators. Pens scribbled notes and questions flew as participants were interested and intrigued by the material presented. During a break for lunch, provided by KP Katering (delicious!), artists retrieved their artwork and viewed other's works. After lunch, our judge, Kay, shared her choices for State and Honorable Mention awards, showing us the aspects of each work that guided her decisions. All participants received a written critique of their submitted works and Kay was available for questions. 
#### **Program is needle felting by Pamm Spooner**





Heyde Center for the Arts, Chippewa Falls, WI September 5 - October 16, 2024 Reception and Awards Ceremony: Sunday, September 8, 2-4 pm

A juried show of 2D and 3D works inspired by or interpretations of the theme, *Arrivals* and *Departures*. The theme can be interpreted broadly or specifically based on concepts and ideas related to arrivals and/or departures.

Open to all artists 18 years and older residing in the states of Wisconsin, Minnesota, Iowa, Illinois, and Michigan. \$40 jury fee allows up to three entries. Entry deadline is August 5 at midnight.
