The goal of SHA is to offer community classes on topics not normally covered by community education offerings and not being currently taught by anyone else. This is a way to help keep these heritage arts alive in our community. If you see one you feel confident in teaching and are interested in, please, indicate what topic(s) and when you might be willing to teach.

Reimbursement to teachers will be \$50/hour teaching time through the VAA and there will be defined minimum enrollment for each class. The teacher will be responsible for developing a class plan and samples of proposed class content which will be reviewed by the SHA committee; and to advise the SHA committee of the supplies that would be needed. SHA will order and pay for the supplies.

Our goal is to offer classes in daytime, evening, and also during summer hours. Fall and Spring classes will be scheduled through the Cardinal Community Learning Center(CCLC) in Chippewa Falls.

Summer classes will be managed through the VAA SHA committee. Please consider when you might be available for any classes you indicate interest in.

When you complete the form select SUBMIT button. You will receive an email copy of the form you submitted.

The SHA committee will contact you if you indicate interest. The first classes will be in the spring semester beginning the end of January.
