Tertiary Colors

Tertiary colors, also known as secondary colors or intermediate colors, are a combination of a primary color and a secondary color that are adjacent on the color wheel. They are always named with the primary color first, yellow-green, yellow-orange, red-violet, red-orange, blue-violet, blue-green. These six tertiary colors complete the basic 12-color wheel by filling the spaces between the six primary and secondary colors.
